Game Objectives:

- a) Simon Says (leadline only) - riders perform maneuvers as called by announcer (no winner, ribbons for all)
- 1) Ball & Cone Race** - Individual timed run to cone, drop ball in cone, return - if ball misses cone; no time is recorded for run.
- 2) Egg & Spoon** - Class shows horse at variety of gaits while holding an egg in a spoon; last rider holding egg wins.
- 3) Mailbox Race - Individual timed run to first mailbox, remove envelope, proceed to second mailbox, insert envelope and put up flag to end time.
- 4) Pairs Class - Team holds crepe paper between them, last team with intact paper wins.
- 5) Walking Race - Riders ride out on the rail at the walk, try to pass the person in front at the walk only. Horses breaking gait or getting passed are eliminated and go to center. Last one still walking wins.
- 6) Stepping Stone Race - Individual timed run to stepping stones- rider dismounts, leads horse while stepping on EVERY stone, then leads horse to finish.
- 7) Musical Poles - Horses walk in a circle around poles (one fewer than riders) while music plays, when music stops, each rider grabs a pole, one rider per pole. The rider without a pole gets eliminated. Repeat until one rider left.
- 8) Pole Bending – Individual timed run, rider weaves in and out of poles, departs and returns directly to finish line. Missing poles = no time, penalties for knocked down poles.
